


YOU NEED TO KNOW

- 'C' is the minimum acceptable grade for all courses in the Teacher Education Program except CMST 101 and ENG 102 or their equivalents, which have a minimum acceptable grade of 'B', and PSY 100, which has no minimum passing grade.
- The Admission Semester, Professional Semester I, and Professional Semester II are "blocks." The classes in these groups must be taken together in the same semester. You may take other classes with these blocks if appropriate.
- Teaching Methods courses must be taken with either Professional Semester
- All required courses must be completed with minimum grades and GPAs met before entering the Clinical Experience, and no other classes may be taken with it.
